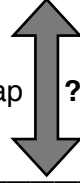

FOR YOU

Commit to coming into God's throne room each day to pray, "Here I am, send me." Put your "5-2Thrive Jar" into practice.

FOR COUPLES

Begin putting your "5-2Thrive Jar" into practice, beginning with prayer together each day for the people you've listed on the jar.

FOR PARENTS

1. Explain the significance of the "5-2Thrive Jar" and how it works. Have each of your children choose a name (or family) to write on one week of the jar so they are invested in the whole idea. Parents, you choose someone too.
2. If you have more than one child, they can take turns enjoying the candy reminders, one per day.
3. Take the time to model *how* to pray for unsaved people and express God's love for them. For some, this may involve a realization that some people don't know Jesus and are still lost without him. Don't just pray, "Lord, help so and so." Get more specific, especially with older kids: What would have to change in order for this person or family to come to a full and joyful faith in Christ? Ask God for that together.

Older/grand parents: If your grown children are attending DCC, touch base about living a 5-2Thrive lifestyle. If not, show them your jar and explain how it works.
